This event will offer excellent opportunities to gather updated information regarding the JCM.

Outline: Japan and 16 partner countries are cooperatively developing and implementing the Joint Crediting Mechanism (JCM), which is one of international market based mechanisms in active operation. The recent progress, achievements and expectations on the implementation of the JCM will be reported and discussed. A framing presentation will be given by Mr. Niclas Svenningsen from the UNFCCC to share the updates on UNFCCC discussions on market mechanisms.
